This book is a concise, yet comprehensive, and systematically covers wide spectrum of orthopaedics with each section given importance it deserves. Point wise arrangement of the book will be very useful to students and trainees preparing for both national and international examinations. Many useful clinical pearls can be found in this book, particularly in the evaluation of the symptoms and the interpretation of radiographs and laboratory data of the symptomatic patients.
